

**CITY OF BURLINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 992**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, COLORADO FOR THE 2023 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 9.11 of the Burlington Code of Ordinances the Council may make supplemental appropriations by ordinance during the fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the City Administrator, James Keehne, has verified that additional funds are available for appropriations in the Conservation Trust fund from actual and anticipated revenues of the current year and prior year cash reserves; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is advised that certain revenues, expenditures and transfers must be approved by ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to comply with the "Local Government Law". (C.R.S. 29-1-101 et seq.); and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That the total appropriation for the 2023 budget in the Conservation Trust Fund expenditures be increased by an additional \$26,000 provided through fund balance; and,

The City Council finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for reconciling the 2023 budget: therefore, this ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after publication thereof.


