***Rules for returning to work and providing services on April 27, 2020***

With the relaxing of the Stay At Home Order for Colorado, Hair and Nail Salons will be allowed to open again under certain provisions. Local Public Health has been tasked with setting the parameters for this to occur. Please follow the rules that have been established for salons in Kit Carson County.

1. Prior to accepting the client into the salon, conduct a questionnaire establishing that the client is not ill. Ask the following questions:
  - a. Do you have a cough?
  - b. Do you have a fever?
  - c. If you have been sick, have your symptoms been gone for at least 14 days?
  - d. Have you been advised that you have been exposed to COVID-19 and are supposed to be in quarantine or isolation?
2. DO NOT PROVIDE SERVICES IF YOU ARE SICK!
3. All salon employees shall wear a mask or face covering at all times while providing services to clients as well as while clients are on the premises. Do not take your mask/face covering on and off during the time that you are providing services.
4. Limit those in the salon to one client per clinician. No waiting in the salon for the chair to open is allowed. Limit families to one parent and one child in the salon at the same time.
5. Clients are also to wear a face covering while on the premises unless it is necessary for them to temporarily remove their covering for application of color or perm. Children younger than 3 years old do not need to wear a face covering.
6. Maintain a 6 foot social distance between you and the client while the client is not in the chair receiving services. If multiple clinicians share the salon, maintain a 6 foot distance between all clients in the salon at all times.
7. Clean the chair and other solid surfaces between clients with a Clorox-based cleaning solution (or comparable product).
8. No walk-ins are allowed. All clients must have an appointment to assure the social distancing measures are being adhered to.

These rules are subject to amendment based on the changing landscape of COVID-19 and additional measures that may come from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.
